Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ,

It's an unusual week and a time of great uncertainty for our nation, our community, and our congregation. With concerns about the coronavirus and the spread of illness altering so much of life for the time being, I want to let you know that your church is here and is ready to love and serve as always. Times like this test our faith, our faith in God and our faith in each other. Therefore, there are three things that I want you to know right now.

First, I want you to know that God is with us in our anxiety, confusion, and fear. The scriptures tell us about many people of faith who were met by God in the most difficult and life changing circumstances. To these people of faith, messengers of God were always saying, "Do not be afraid for God is with you." This is our comfort too. God has promised to abide with us and provide for us and we stand on these promises of God.

Second, I want you to know your church family is ready to help and support you in the days ahead. Staff and leaders at Zion are making plans for ways that we will reach out to people in the congregation and provide care and companionship.
