

Here's what happened in worship this past Sunday.

This week in worship we heard from the gospel of Luke, in this passage we hear Jesus talking to the religious leaders who were upset that He associates with sinners. He answered their criticism with 2 stories. The first story of a shepherd who leaves his flock to find the 1 lost sheep. And similarly the second of a woman who cleans her house to find a lost coin. So it is with God who seeks those who are lost and needing his care. In the sermon Pastor Nathan shared an experience of being lost. Anyone who has forgotten to notify their parents of their whereabouts knows that despite the relief when you return, the reception of your finding is often disappointment and frustration. In the gospel we learn that it's a little different with God. Even when we are at fault God celebrates the lost sheep when they return. We left knowing the good news that even when we are lost, or just feel lost in the moment, there is no shame or guilt awaiting us. With God there is only joy and celebration for His Lost Sheep!
