Here's what happened in worship this past Sunday.

This week in worship we heard from the gospel of Luke, in this passage Jesus tells a story about a rich man and a poor man. Once in heaven the poor man is lifted to heaven and the rich is tormented in the place of the dead. In the story it is made clear that the rich man having ignored the poor all his life sealed his place in the afterlife. But Jesus' stories are never what they seem and he talks about how people on earth have Moses and the prophets to lead them in God's ways. But he goes a little further and asks if someone comes back from the dead will people believe? In the sermon we considered the 2 people in the story and how the world then, and probably now, view them very differently. People assume that earthly possession and ease of life is directly proportionate to God's blessing on their lives. But the good news in this story is that Jesus flips that on its head and they are treated quite opposite in the afterlife. The good news is that Jesus smashes the presumptions of people. He turns them upside uplifting the lowly and calling others to do the same. As we left worship we were both encouraged that in our brokenness we are redeemed, and empowered in our blessings to care for Gods people!
