This week in worship we heard from the gospel of Luke, in this passage Jesus tells us a parable that you should not sit at a high status seat when at a fancy event. This way you will not be embarrassed if asked to move but can only be heightened in prestige if asked to move. Jesus then says if you throw a banquet to invite not the fancy folks but rather the weak, poor, and excluded. In this blessing you will be blessed. In the Sermon Pastor Nathan helped us see these parables as a lesson of kingdom priorities. Humbleness, generosity, kindness these are the characteristics that Jesus wants us to have. We explored how the people of Zion see value in making room for others. In Gods Grace He makes room for us. In response we are called to make room for others to join us at his table. We left worship uplifted and encouraged to go to share the good news that God's table is even bigger than we imagined. Gods table is big enough to connect us despite our divisions, Gods table shows us that we are His all of us are God's and belong here together .
