

## Here's what happened in worship this past Sunday.

This week in worship we heard from the gospel of Luke, in this passage we hear Jesus tell us that he may not be coming to do the things we think he will do. Jesus tells us that he has come not to bring peace but rather great division. In the sermon Pastor Nathan returned to the pulpit after vacation to help us see the good news in this weeks readings. He shared Jesus words again that he will bring division but, like it often does, Jesus' message isn't unidimensional. As we explore the painful divisions the world makes us choose a side on, we see that Jesus' division is in reality an opportunity to be united in Christ. The division that Jesus brings us allows us to discard our idols of belonging to one side or the other, and frees us to choose Christ, it frees us to be one with God. We left worship Sunday knowing that despite the powers around us insisting we are this or that, we can be Christ's people, a people of Love.


