Here's what happened in worship this past Sunday.

This week in worship we heard from the gospel of John, in this passage we hear an interchange between Jesus and a Pharisee named Nicodemus. In it Jesus speaks of being reborn into the spirit, and shares that the religious leaders do not believe in Jesus' teachings and need the spirit in order to make it in the Kingdom of God. In the end Jesus shares the purpose of His time on earth. Jesus shares that "God so loved the world that he gave his only son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but have eternal life." In the sermon Pastor Nathan shared a childhood memory about relying on the mercy of those in charge. In reflecting on this story we can see how maybe Jesus and Nicodemus were talking about receiving mercy to. Nicodemus wanted to will his way into heaven, to play by the rules and be rewarded for it. But Jesus showed him that it's not possible to force our way in, the only way into the Kingdom of God is through Jesus and via God's grace. We left this Sunday knowing that Jesus has already done the work. God has sacrificed his Son so that we are forgiven, so that we can have eternal life.
