

Here's what happened in worship this past Sunday.

This week in worship we heard from the gospel of Luke, in this passage Jesus tells of frightening times to come. He tells of signs that the end is coming. Of wars, and natural disasters, and persecutions. But ends with assurance that the people of God will not perish. In the sermon we reimagined what Jesus may say if he spent a week with us. In this imagined experience, like our gospel lesson, Jesus may say all that is big and important we built would be torn down. In this lesson Jesus says that all these earthly things that seem so important will not last. Pastor Nathan shared a story of businesses that seem too big to fail that ultimately did and what that did to their community. Like the coming destruction of the temple that Jesus foretells, the central pillar to Jewish life, it will all eventually disappear. The good news here is that God endures forever. We should center our lives in the one permanent part of our reality, God. The God who loves and provides for us now and forever.
