Handbells meet each week at 6:15pm in the sanctuary. Come ring with us!



### Fun Facts About Some Favorite Carols

- While we associate Jingle Bells with Christmas, the song was written by James Lord Pierpont to celebrate Thanksgiving.
- The first Christmas song to mention Santa Claus was Benjamin Hanby's *Up On The Housetop. Written in 1864, Hanby was inspired Clement Moore's 1823 poem "A Visit from Saint Nicholas."*
- O Come, O Come Emmanuel is one of the oldest Christmas hymns to still get airplay. Originally composed in Latin during the twelfth century, it was translated into English by John Mason Neale in 1851.
- Irving Berlin hated Elvis Presley's version of White Christmas so much that he tried to prevent radio stations from playing Presley's cover.
- In 1906, a violin solo of O Holy Night was the second piece of music to be broadcast to ever be broadcast on radio.
- Hark! The Herald Angels Sing and Joy to the World are two of the oldest English language Christmas hymns, originating in the 1700s.
